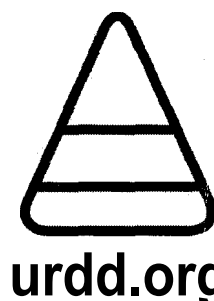

## TEMPORARY CARAVAN PARK – Rules & Conditions for bookings

1. The Caravan Park will be open from 6:00 p.m. Friday evening, 25<sup>th</sup> May until 12:00 noon, Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2007
2. Every vehicle and caravan must leave the site by midday, Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2007.
3. Every caravan must contain a dry powder fire extinguisher specifically for use within the caravan and containing at least 900gms of powder (It is also recommended, for your own safety, that you have a suitable fire blanket stored in the cooking area of the caravan in case of emergencies).
4. Facilities will be provided on site for the safe disposal of wastewater and the contents of chemical toilets. No bookings will be accepted, or caravans allowed on site, without their own self-contained toilet. Proof of such provision may be requested before access is allowed. Wastewater discharged from the caravan must be collected in appropriate secure containers prior to disposal at the nominated locations on the caravan site.
5. Admission to any vehicle or caravan is on the understanding that the Eisteddfod will not be responsible for any loss or damage to:-
  - i) Any caravan, vehicle or other property
  - ii) Any other item in or around the car/caravan howsoever it is caused.
  - iii) Any injury to person/persons.
6. You are requested not to bring dogs with you if at all possible. If you must bring a dog then it must be restrained by a lead at all times and prevented from fouling any area of the caravan park except in an area designated by the Eisteddfod organisers.
7. One car only will be allowed per pitch unless the additional payment of £12.00 for the period has been made. It is not permitted for any person to sleep in the car overnight.
8. Special passes will be distributed for display on the windscreen of those vehicles permitted on site. This sticker must be clearly displayed on the windscreen/front window of the car/caravan. Access to the site for any vehicle will not be permitted without these stickers.
9. The caravan should be parked with the hitch directly above the peg indicating the pitch number.
10. The speed limit on site is 5mph at all times.
11. Access to site a caravan after 9.00pm will not be allowed.
12. Noise should be kept to the absolute minimum after 11.00pm.
13. Every caravanner is expected to keep the site clean and tidy and take any bags of rubbish to the appropriate disposal point on site.
14. It is not permitted to wash at any of the drinking water taps on site. Elsan containers should be washed using the taps provided alongside the chemical toilet disposal points. Care should be taken to turn off all taps after use.
15. The Countryside Code should be adhered to at all times and you should be aware that you are on agricultural land. All gates should be closed after passing through.
16. Parents are responsible for the appropriate behaviour of their children and ensuring their safety at all times.
17. If any breach occurs of these Rules and Terms of hiring a pitch on the caravan site, the organisers reserve the right to terminate the pitch hire immediately and also reserve the right to take any further appropriate action that they consider necessary. Should this situation arise then any fees paid will be forfeited in full.
18. **If you wish to be positioned on site alongside a friend/colleague please return both forms together noting this requirement.**  
**Please Note** – it is not possible to locate a caravan with a power supply adjacent to another caravan that does not have a power supply.
19. The power supply to each caravan pitch is limited to 10Amps. If the circuit is overloaded then it will automatically disconnect the power. It can be reset but if it reoccurs then the supply will be permanently disconnected. No refund will be made if this occurs.
20. Pitches will be allocated in the order that the bookings are received in the Eisteddfod Office.
21. All completed application forms for a pitch on the caravan site should be returned, with the appropriate fee, to the following address **Carafannau, Adran yr Eisteddfod, Urdd Gobaith Cymru, Canolfan Mileniwm Cymru, Plas Bute, Caerdydd, CF10 5AL**, as soon as possible.
